SIXTEENTH STREET COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER APPOINTS SOCIAL WORKER

Position to Conduct Counseling, Provide Client Referrals

MILWAUKEE -- The Sixteenth Street Community Health Center, located at 1032 S. 16th Street, recently added Alison Sergio to its team of four full-time social workers.

"Last year, more than 10,000 patient visits were made to the Social Services Department for a number of social needs, including mental health services and family violence," said John Bartkowski, the Center's chief executive officer. "Ms. Sergio's varied work experience with troubled teenagers and parenting groups will help our clients overcome some of their health problems and take control of their lives."

In addition to referring clients to appropriate social and welfare services and maintaining client records, Ms. Sergio will work with the Center's director of social services to establish referral connections with outside agencies and provide crisis intervention.

A resident of Milwaukee, Ms. Sergio previously held positions at Catholic Social Services and House of Peace, both in Milwaukee. She received her bachelor's of science degree in social work from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee.
