# **PVCHC's Annual Funding Sources for 2008**

- 49% of revenues generated from patient visits (Medicaid; Medicare, CICP, co-pays, private insurance, etc.)
- 51% other funding includes:
  - ➤ 15% In-kind contribution, foundation revenue, donations, and other revenue
  - ➤ 16% Federal funding
  - ➤ 20% State support
- Donated pharmaceuticals totaled \$4,440,279
- Donated professional services and supplies totaled \$379,044

### **Charity Care Provided**

- \$12,624,606 in charity care provided for medical, dental, behavioral health and health education services.
- 39% of total yearly charges is charitable care.
- Less than ½ % of charges in 2008 were bad debt and not included in the above number.

# PVCHC Staff for FY2008 383 Full-Time Equivalents

- 61 Providers: (27 Physicians, 5 Dentists, 2 Dental Hygienists, 3 Midwives, 22 Physician Assistants/Nurse Practitioners, 2 Behavioral Health Professionals)
- 194 Direct medical support (nurses, lab, pharmacy, etc.)
- 87 Medical outreach and support
- 80 Administrative support

#### **Patient Income Level**

- 71% at or below poverty level
- 28% at or below 250% of the poverty level
- 1% do not qualify for public programs & are not insured (pay full fee)

  '08 Federal poverty guidelines: \$ 10,400 income for a single person; \$ 22,200 for a family of four.

- 47.4% White
- 35.0% Hispanic
- 10% African American
- 7.6% Other

# Age of Patients

- 19% Preschool (0-4 years)
- 26% School Age (5-19 years)
- 30% Young Adults (20-44 years)
- 19% Adults (45–64 years)
- 6% Seniors (65+ years)

# **Other Key Points:**

- PVCHC leverages every dollar granted by the Federal Government into \$3.58 of healthcare.
- PVCHC providers delivered 1,211 newborns, with a low birth weight rate under 7.7%.
- PVCHC filled 154,448 prescriptions.
- 85% of expenses support direct services (auditor's efficiency report).
- 21% of our patients are best served in a language other than English.
