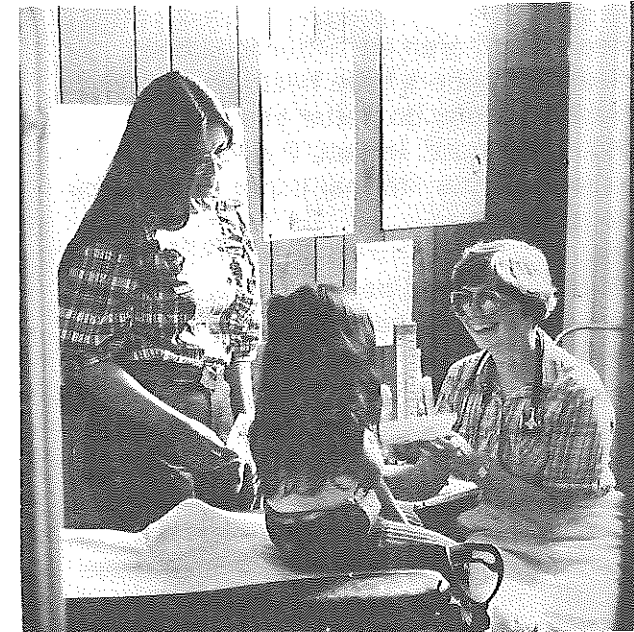

- 16th Street is sponsored by H.O.P.E., Inc., a not-for-profit corporation directed by community residents and health professionals.
- 16th Street began in 1969 with a staff of five and several hundred clients in its first year. In 1984, 16th Street's staff of thirty will provide over 10,000 patient visits.
- 16th Street primarily serves Milwaukee residents who live on the near southside.
- 16th Street is supported by patient fees, federal and state grants, and contributions from United Way of Greater Milwaukee and other charitable organizations. Recent building renovations were financed with a grant from the City of Milwaukee Community Development Agency.
- All contributions to 16th Street are tax-deductible.

16TH STREET

- Checkups and treatment of illnesses for babies, children, teenagers and adults.
- Prenatal care, including pregnancy testing and care, and delivery at St. Mary's Hospital.
- Pharmacy services.

16th Street accepts all health insurance payments, including Title 19 and Medicare. For patients without insurance, fees are based on ability to pay.

16th Street patients who are members of HealthReach HMO receive all covered services free of charge.

Our doctors are on the staff of St. Mary's Hospital. Childbirth, in-hospital care, x-ray and some lab services are provided there. Special care for children is provided at Children's Hospital.

16th Street is a member of HealthReach Health Maintenance Organization, the Wisconsin Public Health Association, the Wisconsin Primary Health Care Association, the National Association of Community Health Centers and the local Coalition for Community Health Care.

The following services are offered free of charge at the 16th Street Community Health Center.

- Blood pressure checkups.
- Information and education on avoiding illness, helping your children stay healthy, and answers to questions on reproductive health and sexuality.
- Information and advice on good diets for expectant mothers, children, those with special medical problems and those wishing to lose weight.
- Vouchers for free nutritious foods and nutrition education for pregnant women, nursing mothers and children under five (WIC program participants only).
- Individual, couple and family counseling; information and referral for other social service needs.
- Legal information, provided by Legal Action of Wisconsin (Wednesday mornings only). Call 278-7722 at other times.
